ACCOMMODATION

The FIS Cup Ski Jumping Wisła 2012 Organizing Committee takes care of the full board accommodation for the athletes and officials, thus all the bookings and accommodation request shall be sent directly to the LOC of Wisła address.

The bookings for national teams are organized by the OC according to the teams' requests and sent entries.

The price for the daily full board accommodation is

- 35 Euro per person FB (START hotel)
- 40 Euro per person FB (GEOVITA hotel)

If there are any NSF who had made their own accommodation arrangements, these are obliged to inform the LOC about the fact not later than August, 29th

The LOC does not guarantee the availability of accommodation for requests and entries sent later than August, 29th

However, if there are vacant rooms left at the OC's disposal these will be provided to teams on request.
